

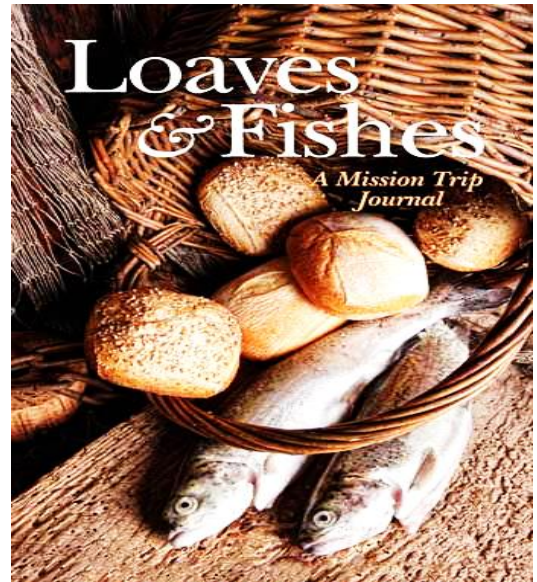

## DEACON'S CORNER

### Deacon's Corner – The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord

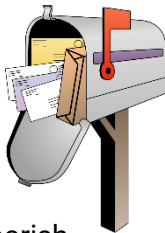
On Tuesday, August 6, we will celebrate the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord. The Gospels of Matthew, Mark, and Luke describe the Transfiguration with remarkable agreement. Tradition names Mount Tabor as the site of this miraculous occurrence. In the Gospel of St. Mark, we hear, "Jesus took Peter, James, and his brother John, and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves. And he was transfigured before them, and his clothes became dazzling white, such as no fuller on earth could bleach them . . . Then a cloud came, casting a shadow over them; from the cloud came a voice, 'This is my beloved Son. Listen to him'" ([9:2-10](#)).

This event occurs after Peter's profession of faith that Jesus is the Messiah (Luke 9:20). It is Our Savior's first revelation of His death and resurrection. St. Thomas Aquinas explains that the Transfiguration occurred because "the divine glory which was Christ's was allowed for a moment to shine through His human body. He did this so that His disciples could taste for a short time the contemplation of eternal joy, in view of the persecutions they would suffer."

The late Archbishop Joseph Raya described the Transfiguration "not simply as an event out of the two-thousand-year-old past, or a future yet to come. It is rather a reality of the present, a way of life available to those who seek and accept Christ's nearness."

## EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### **First Reading: Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15**

The Israelites complain that Moses led them to the desert and there is no food for them there. Then the Lord told Moses he would rain down bread from heaven so the people might know that **Al**, the Lord, am your God. **@** God did as he had promised and in the morning the people found the bread that he had given them.

### **Second Reading: Ephesians 4:17, 20-24**

Paul tells the Ephesians that they must give up their old way of life and live in accordance with the truth that Christ has brought them. He reminds them to acquire a spiritual way of thinking, and to remember that they are made in God=s image and act accordingly.

### **Gospel: John 6:24-35**

The people Jesus had fed on five loaves of bread follow him, and Jesus tells them they should not be looking for perishable food, but for spiritual food. The people want a sign that they should believe in him. He explains that he is the bread of life, and anyone who believes will not experience hunger or thirst. The people did not fully understand that he was speaking in the spiritual sense, and not of actual food.
