### Deacon's Corner

The feast of St. Elizabeth of Hungary, the daughter of the King of Hungary, will be celebrated on Wednesday, November 17. She devoted herself to a life of penance and a great love for the poor and the suffering. Her service to those in need helped her become the patroness of all Catholic Charities and the Secular Franciscan Order.

At the age of 14, Elizabeth married and had three children. Throughout her life, she dressed in simple clothes and diligently practiced works of mercy. She lived a life of service to justice and charity, in the constant search for the common good.

As a secular Franciscan, she also cared for the sick at a hospital that she founded in honor of St. Francis of Assisi. She died before her 24<sup>th</sup> birthday and was canonized a saint four years later. St. Elizabeth is the patron saint of bakers, hospitals, brides, homeless and charities.
