Deacon's Corner

The feast of the Exultation of the Holy Cross will be celebrated on Wednesday, September 14. Our Savior, Jesus Christ, sacrificed His life on this precious and life-giving Cross for our salvation. The Gospel of St. John reminds us, "God so loved the world that He gave his only Son" (3:16). The Father gave His only Son to save each of us and to conquer sin and death. This feast also remembers two historic events. The first event is the finding of the relic of the True Cross by St. Helena in 324; and the second is the building of the first churches in Jerusalem by her son, Constantine, the emperor of Rome. The churches were built in Christ's tomb, where He rose from the dead and at Calvary where His passion and death occurred.

The following day, on Thursday, September 15, the memorial of Our Lady of Sorrows is commemorated. This feast reminds us of the seven sorrows of Jesus' Mother: Simeon's prediction that "you yourself a sword will pierce" (St. Luke 2:35); the flight into Egypt (St. Matthew 2:13, 14); the loss of the Child Jesus in the temple (St. Luke 2:43-48); the meeting of Jesus and Mary on the Way of the Cross; the Crucifixion; the taking down of the Body of Jesus from the Cross; and the burial of Jesus.
