Deacon's Corner

The Feast of the Chair of St. Peter, the Apostle, will be celebrated on Tuesday, February 22. In the Gospel on this feast day, Jesus says to Peter, "And so I say to you, you are Peter, and upon this rock I will build my Church, and the gates of the netherworld shall not prevail against it. I will give you the keys to the Kingdom of heaven. Whatever you bind on earth shall be bound in heaven; and whatever you loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven."

(Matthew 16: 18-19)

This feast day is a celebration of the mission of teacher and pastor entrusted to St. Peter by Jesus. We also celebrate the unity of our Church. The Roman Missal emphasizes that the mission that Christ conferred upon Peter, to whom He formed in his person and in St. Peter's successors, is a visible foundation of the unity of the Church.
