## Deacon's Corner

The feast of St. Bernardine of Siena, Priest, will be celebrated on Friday, May 20. St. Bernardine joined the Franciscan order in 1403. Two years later, he was ordained a priest. At first, Bernardine did very little preaching and missionary work because his voice was "weak and hoarse". For 12 years, he spent his energy in prayer, solitude and spiritual preparation. Then he went to Milan on a mission and began preaching the Gospel to all in "a strong and commanding voice."

Pope Pius II called him "a second St. Paul" because of his eloquent missionary work and preaching.

St. Bernardine had a special devotion to the Holy Name of Jesus and created the IHS symbol in a blazing sun, which is the first three letters of the name of Jesus in Greek. This symbol began to appear in churches and homes.

May we ask St. Bernardine to pray for us as we discover and share our talents in charity with one another.
