Christ has Risen! Indeed, He is Risen!
Our Lord, the Light of the World, has risen and triumphed over sin and death for our eternal salvation. Through His Glorious Resurrection we have been saved.

In John's Gospel on Easter Day, we hear that "Mary of Magdala came to the tomb early in the morning, while it was still dark, and saw the stone removed from the tomb. So, she ran and went to Simon Peter and to the other disciple whom Jesus loved and told them 'They have taken the Lord from the tomb"...Peter and the other disciples came to the tomb and went in and saw the burial cloths there.
