Deacon's Corner

St. Dominic, Priest

The Memorial of St. Dominic, Priest, will be celebrated on Tuesday, August 8. St. Dominic was born to a noble and holy family in Caleruega, Spain, in 1170. He studied at the University of Palencia for ten years. During this time, he sold his possessions and collection of books to help the poor.

St. Dominic established the Order of Friar Preachers—the Dominicans. These friars live simple and austere lives. This order was to be supported by alms and still is to the present day. The work of this order is preaching and study. St. Dominic preached in France, Spain and Italy. He is the patron saint of astronomers and falsely accused people.

St. Dominic had a vision of the Blessed Mother, who showed him a wreath of roses, representing the rosary. She told St. Dominic to pray the rosary daily, to teach it to others, and that true faith will triumph in the end. St. Dominic is often credited with the rosary, but it pre-dates him. He certainly encouraged people to pray the rosary. The rosary strengthened his own spiritual life.

On his feast day, let us pray the prayer of St. Dominic, "May God the Father, who made us, bless us. May God the Son, who redeemed us, send healing into our midst. May God the Holy Spirit, who gives us life, move within us. May God give us eyes to see God, ears to hear God, and hands to bring God's work into the world."
