Deacon's Corner

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord will be celebrated on Wednesday, February 2. In the Gospel of St. Luke on this day, we hear that "Mary and Joseph took Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord, just as it is written in the law." When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the law....they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.

(2:22-23; 2:39-40)

Simeon had been promised by the Holy Spirit that he would see "Christ of the Lord" before his death. When Simeon saw the child in the temple, he proclaimed, "Now, Master, you may let your servant go....for my eyes have seen your salvation, which you prepared in the sight of all the peoples: a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel."

(2:29-32)

Like Simeon, the prophetess Anna also recognizes the Lord as the light of the world through the power of the Holy Spirit. Through this same Spirit, as we pray and read holy Scripture, Jesus comes and is present in the temples of our hearts to be a light and hope in our daily lives. May we ask and welcome Him to be present in our hearts.
