Deacon's Corner

During the Octave of Christmas, the feast of St. John the Evangelist, one of Jesus' Apostles, will be celebrated on Monday, December 27. Also known as the "Beloved Apostle", he was the son of Zebedee, A Galilean fisherman and the brother of another Apostle of Christ, St. James. St. John was called by Jesus to be one of His disciples as he was mending his fishing nets.

St. John was the evangelist who wrote the fourth Gospel and the Book of Revelation. In the beginning of his Gospel, Saint John proclaims with great beauty that Jesus is "the Light of the World". During his earthly ministry, John had the privilege to be with Jesus during special events in Our Savior's life. He was with his brother James and St. Peter when they witnessed the Transfiguration of Christ on the mountain. At His Crucifixion, Jesus entrusts the care of His Mother, Mary, to St. John. Legend tells us that St. John lived to an old age and died of natural causes. He is the patron saint of friendships and authors.

May we ask St. John to pray for us, "O Glorious St. John, you were so loved by Jesus that you merited to rest your head upon his chest at the Last Supper and to care for His Blessed Mother. Obtain for us an ardent love for Jesus and Mary. Let us be united with them now on earth and forever after in heaven."
