Deacon's Corner – Ash Wednesday

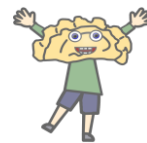
This year, Ash Wednesday will be celebrated on
March 2. This special day begins our Lenten journey
which will end on Thursday, April 15 at the Mass of
the Lord's Supper. Lent is a time of prayer and
repentance – a time to turn away from sin. As the
ashes are placed on the person's forehead, the
priest, deacon, or extraordinary minister will pray,
"Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall
return." They may also pray, "Repent and believe in
the Gospel." These blessed ashes are a symbol of
penance and to remind us to practice a spirit of
humility and sacrifice in our lives as Jesus' disciples.
On this first day of Lent, Pope Francis asks us "to
remember the One who humbled Himself and
became obedient unto death, even death on the
cross." Ash Wednesday begins our journey of faith
as we walk with Jesus to His Holy Cross and to the
celebration of His Resurrection and victory over sin
and death on Easter Sunday. On this day, may we
pray, "Lord, thank you for giving us this time during
Lent to be filled and empowered by your Holy Spirit.
As we enter fully into Lent, show us what we need to
see and do to more fully follow your Gospel."
