The Ascension of the Lord

The Ascension of the Lord, a day of great joy,
will be celebrated on Thursday, May 18. On this
day, Jesus Christ ascends into heaven and
takes His seat at the right hand of God the
Father. The Ascension takes place 40 days after
the Resurrection of our Savior. During the 40
days after Easter Sunday, Christ was teaching
the Apostles and discussing the Kingdom of
God with His disciples.

With his ascension into heaven, He came to
show us the way to God's heavenly kingdom.

Our Lord wants all of us to be with Him in
heaven and to live in eternal happiness. Today
is also a day that we need to think about and act
upon the mission of our lives. In today's first
reading and Gospel, Jesus speaks His last word
while on earth. He says to His disciples and us,
“You will be my witnesses.....to the ends of the
earth” (Acts of Apostles, 1:8).

Jesus is calling us to be His witnesses in this
world. He wants us to proclaim his love and
mercy in our words and actions. As his
disciples, we need to love the people in our lives,
to forgive them, and to humbly serve them in
Jesus' name. Let us pray for the Holy Spirit's
help that we may be faithful witnesses of Our
Lord.
