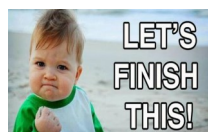

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

The Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a holy day of obligation, will be celebrated on Friday, August 15.
