The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, the Apostles will be celebrated this Sunday, June 29. St. Peter and St. Paul are two Apostles of Christ who preached and spread the Good News in the early church and to this day. St. Peter was given the keys to heaven as Jesus' vicar on earth and as the first pope. St. Paul wrote many Scriptural readings and evangelized people in the name of Christ.

These two saints remind us of our call to be witnesses for Christ in our lives. We are encouraged to live out our faith through our actions and words and to share Jesus' message of love with others. It is also a day to reflect on our own of our faith and how we can be more active in spreading the Gospel in our community.
