## ."The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and **Blood of Christ**

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is this Sunday, June 22. This solemnity is also known as Corpus Christi Sunday. This feast occurs two weeks after Pentecost and celebrates the real and living presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Jesus is truly present Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Eucharist. In the second reading on this Sunday, in the Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul writes, "Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, and, after he had given thanks, broke it, and said, 'This is my body that is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me'" (1 Corinthians 11: 23-26). The Holy Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life" (Catechism of Catholic Church, 1324). St. Pope John Paul II emphasizes that "Jesus awaits us in this sacrament of love." Our Lord gives us the Eucharist as spiritual nourishment because He loves us. Through the Eucharist, we become united with Him, "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (John 6:56) (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops website).

On this feast, may we pray, "Jesus, thank you for the sacred gift, your Body and Blood. May I be mindful of your presence in the Eucharist and live a life that reflects your love."
